NATURAL AND GEOGRAPHICAL CHARACTERISTICS


Kremenchuk is a city of regional significance, the administrative and industrial center of Ukraine.

The city is located in the zone of moderate continental climate within the Dnieper Lowland and the middle stream line of the Dnieper on its left and right banks, in the central part of Ukraine.


The climate of the territory is moderately continental. Winter is mild with mostly cloudy weather and frequent thaws. Frosts are usually weak. Summer is warm, some years hot and droughty. Average temperature in winter: + 8-12 °C, in the summer: + 20- + 28.

The territory of the city comprises 9586 hectares, the length from north to south — 30 km.

The city is located 119 km from the city of Poltava and 286 km from Kiev.



Kremenchuk is a significant railway junction, which city has direct rail links with many regions of the country.



The Dnieper is a main water artery of Kremenchuk, and in particular its part, which was transformed into Dniprodzerzhynsky reservoir, which divides the city on the left bank (Kremenchuk) and right bank (Kriukov). The advantage of the city is the availability of cargo and passenger ports. Kremenchuk river port, which is located on the left bank of the Dnieper, serves cargo transportations, mainly in the direction of Kyiv, Kamenka, Kherson, and Dnipro.

The city is in a favorable position at the intersection of important transport communications, which provide Kremenchuk convenient connections with the main industrial centers of the central and eastern part of Ukraine — Kiev, Poltava, Kharkiv, Dnipro, Nikolaev, Kamyansky, Kropivnitsky and others.

The transport links of the city with the regional center, the capital of the state and other countries are carried out by road, railways and, in part, by water transport.

The city is connected with:

- ~ the international highway Alexandria–Poltava (M-22);
- ~ national highway Borispol–Dnepropetrovsk–Zaporozhye (H-08);
- ~ regional highway of state significance Kaniv–Chigirin–Kremenchuk (P-10);
- ~ territorial roads of local importance: Khorol–Semenivka–Kremenchuk (T-17-16), Kremenchuk–Komsomolsk (T-17-11);
- ~ a number of local roads (district and village) linking Kremenchuk with adjacent inhabited localities.

Auto-roads: the length of highways of national and local importance — 310 km, trolleybus networks — 145 km, the city has 4 roundabouts.

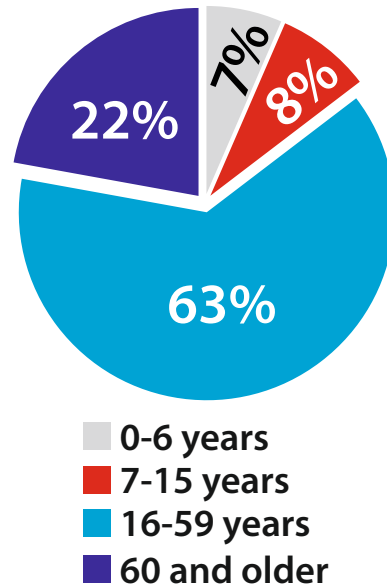


POPULATION AND LABOR POTENTIAL

The number of unemployed were registered in the city-center of employment as of 01.02.2018. comprises 2346 people.

The city has a significant number of internally displaced persons (IDPs) — 3892 people, which is 1.75% of the total population. The number of IDPs for a 10 thousand population is 175 people.

The average monthly salary, charged per one employee in 2016 amounted to 4850 UAH. During the first half of 2017, wages totaled US\$266.

City budget

The main sources of revenues forming the revenue part of the general fund of the city budget are four taxes, which make up 96.1% in the revenue side of the general fund (US\$ 37 638 263,7):

Kremenchuk introduced a new practice of direct democracy — "Public Budget of Kremenchuk". Citizens have the opportunity to submit their idea of city development. If the idea gets the most support during the voting — it will be implemented by the residents together with the city authorities.

Participation budget is a democratic process that enables every citizen to participate in the distribution of local budgets through the creation of projects to improve the city and / or vote for them. Any resident of the city may submit a project related to the improvement of life in the city, to participate in the contest, to win the vote and to monitor how its project will be implemented within the next year's budget.

Projects are aimed at energy saving, innovation, creation of recreation areas and barrier-free urban space, tourism development, etc.

Kremenchuk is one of the most powerful industrial centers in Ukraine with a developed economic and social infrastructure. There are more than 86 industrial enterprises, 58 construction companies of different forms of ownership and more than 14 thousand business

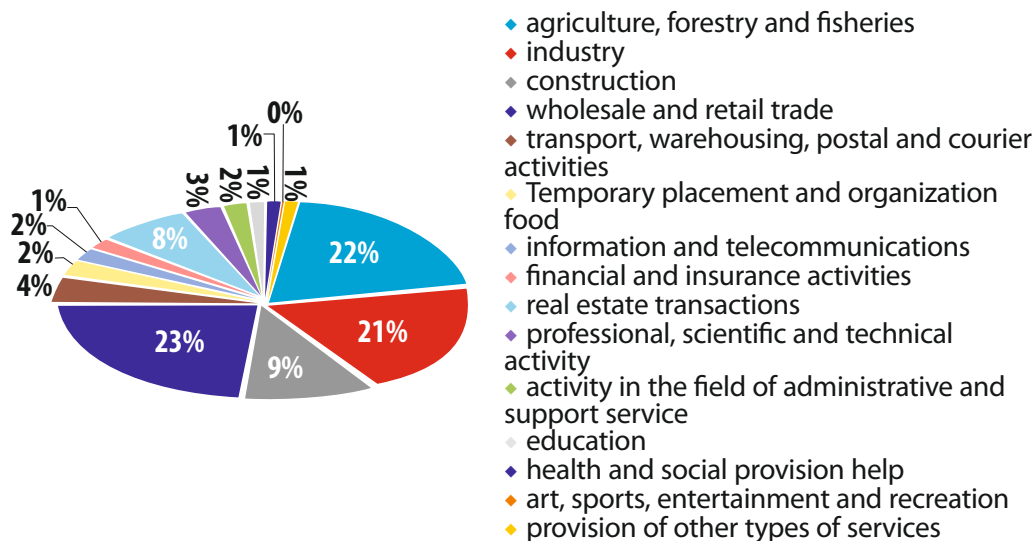


entities operating in the city. The structure of industry covers almost all basic industries, namely: petrochemical, mechanical engineering and metal processing, food processing, textile and footwear and construction industries, the share of which in the total volume of sales is 78.9%.

Branch structure of entrepreneurship in Kremenchuk in the field of economic activity as of the beginning of 2018.

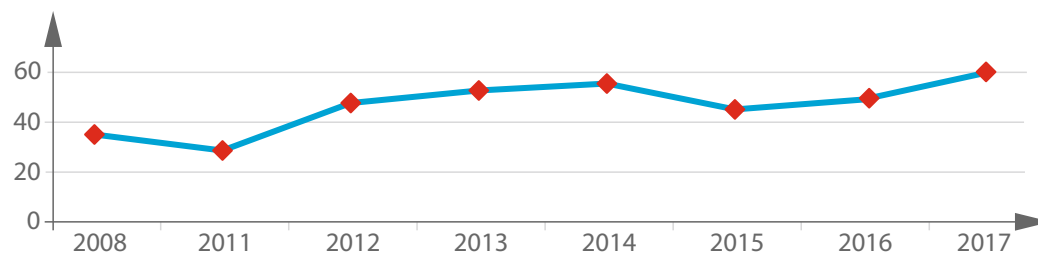


Today there is a positive trend of growth of key industries primarily due to industry, metal-working, mineral deposits in the city.

The volume of sales of industrial production during 9 months of 2017 amounted to 1 741 141,3US\$.

The source of financing of capital investments is still the company's own funds. During January-June 2017, enterprises and organizations at the expense of all sources of financing mastered 624.5 million UAH. capital investment.

SMALL AND MEDIUM BUSINESS

According to KODPI, as of 01.01.2017, the number of small and medium enterprises is 14 986 units, of which:

- ~ number of small business entities – 14 911 units;
- ~ the number of medium-sized enterprises – 75 units.

As of 01.10.2017 in the city there are 1955 retail, restaurant and service sectors.

The trading network of the city is represented by 1012 stores (of which 380 food) and 13 markets.

The number of employees in the small and medium enterprises comprises 28074 persons. An increase in the number of small businesses in individuals caused by the changes in the current legislation concerning the application of penalties for non-execution of hired employees.

FOREIGN ECONOMIC ACTIVITY

EXPORT AND IMPORT

In 2016, exports of goods amounted to 307069,9 thousand dollars, imports -478923,7 thousand dollars. The balance is -171853,8 thousand dollars. Coefficient of export coverage import was 0.64.

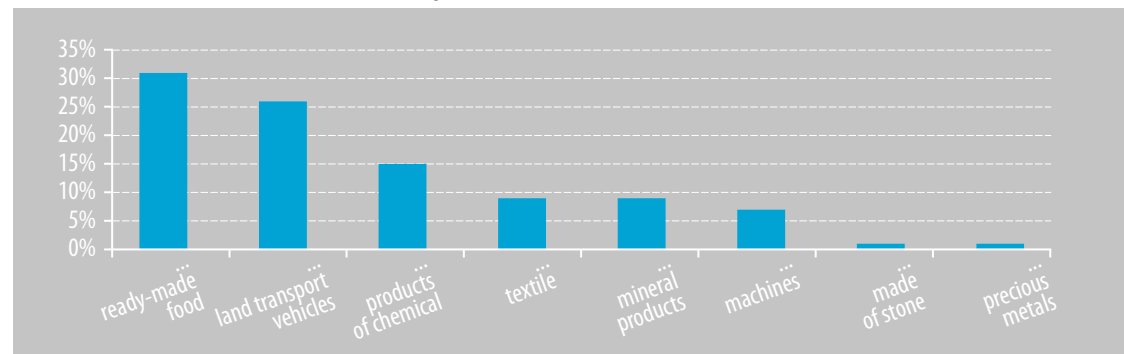
EXPORT OF GOODS. MAIN COUNTRIES (PARTNERS)

During 2013-2016, exporters companies from such countries as the Russian Federation, Uzbekistan, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Egypt, Hungary, Germany, France, Romania, Kazakhstan, Canada, Georgia, Tajikistan, and Finland were the main partners of the city. From the analysis of data obtained during the survey of exporting companies, on average 70% of export supplies goes to the Russian Federation, 20% to the CIS countries, and 7% to the countries of the European Union.

According to the results of 2017, the commodity structure of exports is represented by the following product sections:

- ~ Ready-made food (31%);
- ~ Land transport vehicles, aircraft, floating structures (26%);

- ~ Products of chemical and related industries (15%);
- ~ Textile materials and textiles (9%);
- ~ Mineral products (9%);
- ~ Machines, equipment and machinery; electrical equipment (7%);
- ~ Goods made of stone, gypsum, cement (1%);
- ~ Precious metals and production (1%).



COMMODITY STRUCTURE OF IMPORT

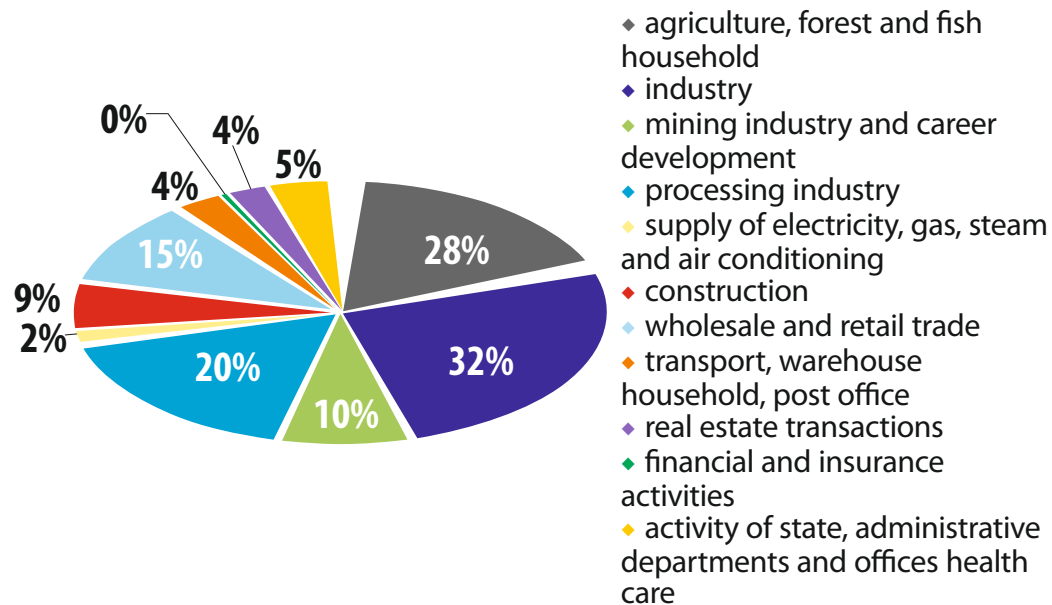
According to the results of 2017, the commodity structure of imports is the following commodity sections:

- Mineral products – 48%;
- Ready-made food products – 14%;
- Production of chemical and related industries – 12%;
- Machines, equipment and machinery; electrical equipment – 7%;
- Textile materials and textiles – 6%;
- Mass of wood or other fibrous cellulosic materials – 5%;
- Ground vehicles, aircraft, floating means – 3%.

EXPORT AND IMPORT OF SERVICES

The volume of city services exports in 2017 amounted to 7560,0 thousand USD, which is 195,9% compared to the corresponding period of the last year, and the import of services — 28706,3,8 thousand USD or 66,2% to the corresponding period of last year. The balance of foreign trade in services was negative and amounted to 38.9 million USD.

The source of financing of capital investments is still the company's own funds. In 2016, enterprises and organizations at the expense of all sources of financing have disbursed 1676316,0 thousand. UAH capital investment. The largest share of investments accrues to industry and processing industry (32 and 20%). Agricultural activity is the second to the city's capital investment.



HOUSING, OFFICE AND INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION INFRASTRUCTURE

The housing facilities stock of the city council accounts for 1159 residential buildings with a total area of 3236.483 thousand square meters. The average physical depreciation of the housing stock is 40-60%.

INFRASTRUCTURE OF BUSINESS SUPPORT AND INVESTMENT ATTRACTION

The business support infrastructure objects includes the Kremenchuk City Business Support Foundation and the Administrative Service Center.

The Administrative Service Center was established in 2015 by the Kremenchuk City Council of the Poltava region in order to provide



accessibility and simplify the reception of administrative service. To date, 165 services are included in the list of services that can be obtained through the ASC in the city of Kremenchuk. The Administrative Service Center is regularly improving the clear system of providing administrative services and conducting activities aimed at simplifying and making the service available.

Kremenchuk Center for International Relations and Economic Development "Kremenchuk Invest" has been established in the Kremenchuk City Council of the Poltava Region in order to attract investment into the city and improve the competitiveness of the city.



"Kremenchuk Invest" carries out the following functions:

- realization of events in the field of local economic development;
- development, implementation and support of investment projects;
- promotion and marketing of the territory;
- development of international cooperation and strengthening the image of the city.

SPHERE OF EDUCATION, HEALTH CARE, CULTURE AND RECREATION

Education

There are 30 general education institutions in Kremenchug with 20,945 students. The training of specialists in Kremenchuk is carried out by 3 vocational schools, 5 colleges and 2 higher educational institutions, where more than 16 thousand students and students receive higher and vocational education, of which more than 6.5 thousand acquire workers' professions.

Kremenchuk Institute of Dnipropetrovsk University of Economics and Law.

Today more than 2000 students study at the Kremenchuk Institute of Dnipropetrovsk University of Economics and Law. Within the framework of this mission, the Kremenchug Institute of the Dnipropetrovsk University of Economics and Law conducts educational and methodological work and the introduction of new standards in education.

The Institute trains specialists in following majors: translation, economic cybernetics, international economics, business economics, marketing, finance and credit, banking, social work, management.

Health care

The medical care of the city's population is carried out by 26 health care institutions. 14 institutions are subordinated to the Health Care Administration of the executive committee of the Kremenchuk City Council. The total capacity, calculated by outpatient clinics, subordinating to the Department of Health of the city council, is 4690 visits per shift. 3 Primary Health Care Centers, operate in Kremenchug as separate legal entities. 2 medical and prophylactic institutions (Kremenchuk Municipal Maternity Hospital and Kremenchug City Children's Hospital) received the international status - "Child Friendly Hospital".

Culture, sports, tourism

Kremenchuk Museum of Local History has been the keeper of the city history for almost 48 years. Today, the Kremenchug Local History Museum is a research, cultural and educational institution with a wide range of activities.

Kremenchuk Art Gallery in Kremenchuk works since 1998. Annually in its halls it takes up to 20 exhibitions of both local authors and artists from other cities of Ukraine.

The Art Gallery of Natalia Yuzefovich, created in 2002 on the basis of a collection of paintings and graphic works in the style of socialist

realism. is an important cultural center of the right-bank part of Kremenchuk-Kriukiv. When it comes to preserving the cultural heritage of Kremenchuk, there are 17 communal institutions of culture work in the city. In order to make the city more attractive to tourists, Kremenchuk people had the opportunity to spend their free time with pleasure and initiate various festivals. The largest was the "Sweet Kremenchuk" festival, which traditionally takes place on the last weekend of September and is dedicated to the Kremenchuk Day.

There are 5 public parks for recreation of Kremenchuk in the city.

In Kremenchuk there are 32 travel agencies and agencies that carry out entrepreneurial activities and provide services in the tourism sector, namely:

- organization of excursions, mass and recreational and sports tourism.

Arranging wholesale market

Organization of the wholesale market for agricultural products involves the creation of a platform of meeting wholesale supply of agricultural products and the corresponding demand at the real price of the goods. The market activity assumes that it will be possible to prepare the goods for sale, carry out calculations, obtain credit, transport services, find out the prices of goods, and also provide the population of Kremenchuk with high-quality agricultural products.

Key events of the project:

1. The choice of the legal form of the farmer's market and its registration in accordance with the current legislation of Ukraine.
2. Selection and registration of land.
3. Involvement of participants interested in creating a farmer's wholesale market.
4. Development of rules and order of trade.
5. Construction of the main areas of the market.

Estimated cost of the project, ths.

38 000,00 UAH / 1 362,0 USD

Reconstruction of the boiler house and construction of the heating main from the boiler house of the blok 17 to the boiler-house of the 620 block of the city of Kremenchuk

Within the framework of the project, in order to increase the coefficient of natural gas use in the heating system of the Kriukivskyi district of Kremenchuk, at the boiler-house of block 17, replace obsolete gas boilers KVG-6,5 with modern boilers with higher efficiency, connecting them with water heat exchangers of waste gases for the heat recovery of combustion products.
